

The Process and Costs





The cost of an Adult ADHD Assessment with our consultants is £1,245. £995 is paid at the time the Assessment is booked.

Where will my appointment be held?



This appointment can be conducted from the comfort of your own **home** with our psychiatrist online or alternatively from our **clinics**.

What is encompassed in the appointment?

- 1 hour Assessment with our consultant.
- Assessment questionnaires and GP records to be provided.
- 30min Feedback Appointment to discuss findings and medication (if required)
- 1st Prescription if medication is recommended. *Medication cost is not included.
- *You will be required to complete your Assessment Questionnaires ahead of your report feedback appointment.

Please note you are required to arrange a feedback appointment to discuss the assessment report. The cost of the feedback appointment is £250.




This additional fee ensures you receive personalised feedback and guidance based on the findings of your assessment.

The Process and Costs



We will require your Assessment Questionnaires to be completed prior to your Report being published and made available to you at your feedback appointment.

There are 8 questionnaires which are completed by you, someone who knew you as a child and someone who knows you now. Your Questionnaires will be emailed to you upon booking your assessment.

You will require follow up appointments if you chose to commence medication for treatment of ADHD. Follow up appointments are typically every 3-4 weeks. The fee for a 30 minute follow up appointment with your consultant is £225.

When you are stabilised on your medication, we can request a Shared Care Agreement (SCA) with your NHS GP. You will still require an annual review appointment (£225) with your consultant at Midland Health when your SCA has been initiated. Please note the initiation of an SCA is at the discretion of your NHS GP, we recommend discussing this with your NHS GP.

If your NHS GP declines your SCA, we can initiate this with our Private GPs at Midland Health.

Your Appointment

These appointments can be arranged as face to face or video consultations. You can conveniently secure your assessment appointment by booking directly on our website or reaching out to our Customer Service team. Please note that the completion of all questionnaires is essential for the final report. Once you have finished all the required documentation, including the questionnaires and providing your GP Summary records, please inform our Neurodiversity Team.

Be aware that we can just carry out an assessment if the patient is based and resident in the UK.

Medication

Please note if you are initiated on medication for treatment of diagnosed ADHD your consultant will only issue prescriptions within their clinics at Midland Health. We do ask for 7 days' notice of an empty prescription so we can process your request and ensure you have your prescription within a timely manner. Prescription requests can take up to 7 working days to process.

You will be contacted by our online pharmacy, Pharmazon, to arrange delivery to your home or to confirm collection from our Birmingham clinic—please let us know your preference.



Please let us know if:

- You are currently facing substance misuse issues.
- You have a diagnosis of Bipolar Affective Disorder.
- You have been diagnosed with Schizophrenia.
- You have a Learning Disability.
- You have been diagnosed with Emotionally Unstable Personality Disorder.

If you have answered yes to any of the above questions, we may be unable to proceed with your assessment at Midland Health.

Directions to the Edgbaston, Birmingham Clinic

23a Highfield Road Edgbaston Birmingham B15 3DP

Our new Mental Health clinic is located in the heart of Edgbaston's medical quarter. The newly refurbished Georgian building boasts 6 clinical rooms as well as a reception and 2 large waiting areas

Parking

Roadside parking is available along Highfield road on the doorstep of our clinic. This is free for up to two hours. There is also a pay and display car park to the right of our neighbouring building. Pay and display car parking in Edgbaston Village can be paid for by contactless, cash or app payments.

Public Transport

The closest Station to our Highfield Road clinic is Fiveways Railway station. Approximately a 15 minute walk from our clinic, the station runs services directly into Birmingham New Street Station, providing us with excellent train links across the country. There is a bus stop located on Highfield Road (Highfield Road Bus Stop), a short walk from the clinic which is serviced by a number of busses.

Our Midland Health Neurodiversity Clinic in London is located at 10 Harley Street, London, one the country's leading medical districts.

Public Transport

There is a bus stop located outside John Lewis, Oxfor Street: 6, 8, 13, 15, 73, 135, 139, 189 & 390. Bond street (Central and Jubilee Lines) and Oxford Circus (Victoria, Bakerloo and Central Lines) are the closest train stations to our Neurodiversity clinic on Harley Street.

Parking

Short-term meter parking is available directly in front of our building number 10 and nearby areas. Westminster parking rates apply Monday to Saturday from 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. m. to 6:30 p.m.

Long-term car parking is available at underground car parks at Cavendish Square and at the rear of Harley Street.

Discounted parking rates are available to our clients with Q-Park Oxford Street, which is based in Cavendish Square, a short distance from our clinic.
